All competition maps are printed on pretex waterproof paper!

Sprint: size: A4 scale:1:5 000 H=5 m
Classics: size: A4 scale:1:10 000 H=5 m

Categories: M14, M16, W14, W16 maximum 5 competitors per team, per category.

Ranking: Individual ranking for each category, for each competition. Team ranking for each category only for the two classics.

Awards: Medals and Certificates.

4. Description of the marking devices:

Registering devices: SportIdent at all controls (NOT in the AIR mode). Control numbers and bands are written on the SI units. There is also a punch stamp at every control in case of sportident fault.

Flags:

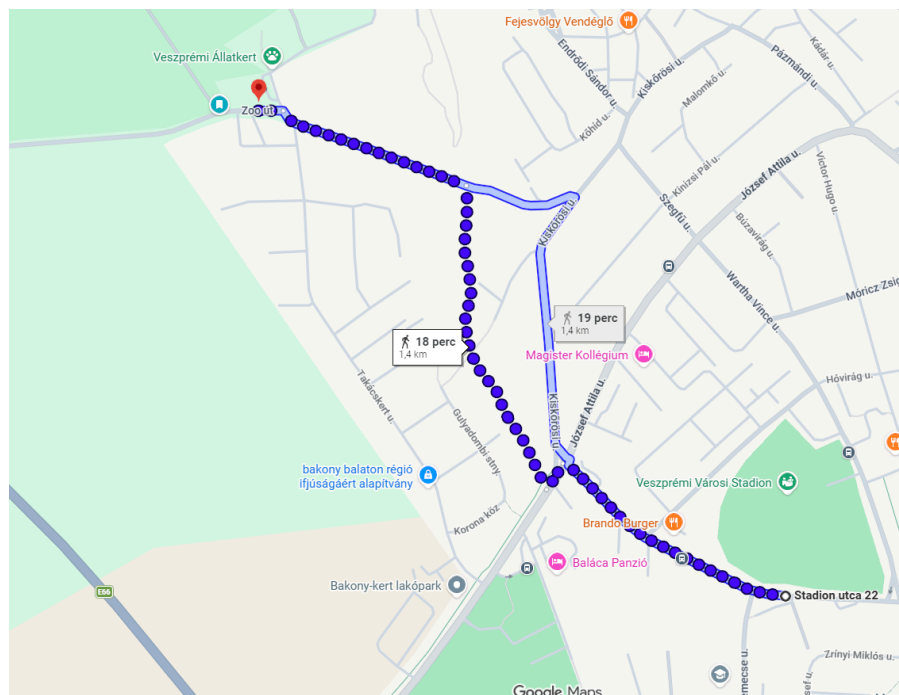
Classics: 30x30 cm 3-sided orange/white flags at all controls
Sprint: 30x30 cm 3-sided orange/white flags at S (spectators) and MO (beacon)
No flags, just red/white striped SI stand at all other controls

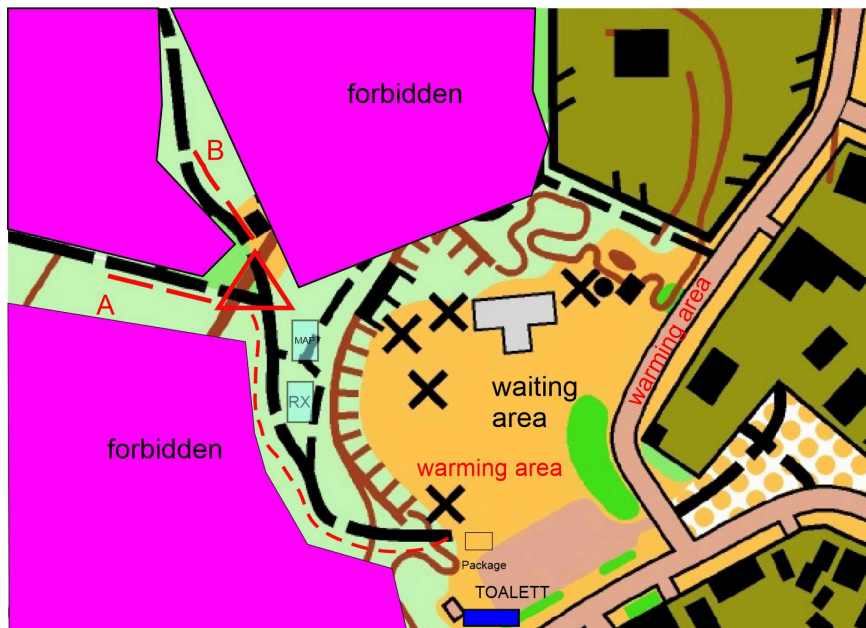

9. EMERGENCY (STORM) during the competition:

In case of a thunderstorm, the Chairman of the Jury may recall the competition. All of the transmitters will be shut down EXCEPT the finish beacon. Every competitor should go to the finish immediately!

10. Other informations:

To gain entrance to the dining area please use your badge given in the start package.

Always put down your keys at the reception before leaving the dormitory.

The number plates can be found in the start package, please put them to the front and the back of your shirt into a clearly visible location. If you lose any of them please contact the organizer the day before the next competition!

Mosquito and tick repellent spray will be provided in the start area.

At the end of the event please remove your bedsheets and place them at the end of the corridor of your level, next to the stairs.

Insurance and medical care

First aid will be positioned at the finish. Minor injuries can be treated free of charge. All participants should purchase medical insurance covering all extra expenses in advance.
